As such, the positions available within the GCC will reflect our commitment to the long term sustainability of the conference.

In charge of overall conference vision are conference Co-chairs, followed by Directors who will oversee some aspect related to the large scale plans. Leadership level is indicative of the breadth of responsibilities more so than one's expected time commitment.

Positions that have been filled internally are the conference co-chairs and Director of High School Programming. Below are short descriptions of the available positions:

Director of Promotions (2 positions): promotes the GCC brand within the McMaster community and to external groups, engages in public relations projects, and executes general promotional ventures.

Director of Programming: responsible for assisting co-chairs in planning workshops, panels, lectures and keynotes of the conference.

IT Coordinator: primarily responsible for conference website, online ticket sales, registration, and electronic promotions. Experience with web site design and maintenance is essential.

Director of Logistics: responsible for logistical issues including venue, room bookings for weekly meetings, catering bookings and enforcing MSU rules within projects.

Director of Finance: responsible for creating budget, maintaining journals, and keeping executive on budget.

Director of External Sponsorship: responsible for securing conference funding from external organizations and companies; involves some work during the summer months.

Director of Internal Sponsorship: responsible for securing conference sponsorship from the various faculties, departments and clubs at McMaster.
